

omise in hand made at and before, the sealing and delivery of these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, and all and convey and confirm unto the said Charles of Eford and to his heirs and assigns forever all that piece, parcel and lot of Land situate lying and being in the town of Newville in the district and state of our said, containing three acres and one quarter more or less, and bounded as follows, beginning at a Rock, at intersection of two streets, and near Sherman and Beallies corner, and running thence with one of said streets seven chains to a stake 1408, thence with my land 1407, six chains eight one links, to a stake, thence with Gilreath and Fawcett's lands 12100 eight chains and twenty links to a stake on the street thence with last mentioned street, 1646 three chains and twenty five links to the beginning, being Lot No 1 of lands purchased by Eford from Jacob Gilreath.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, thenceunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the succession and succeeding remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, To have and to hold the said lot of Land with the appurtenances, unto the said Charles of Eford his heirs and assigns forever.

Provided always, nevertheless, and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties to these presents that if the said John B Smith his, heirs executors or administrators shall prudently pay or cause to be paid, unto the said Charles of Eford the sum of seven hundred dollars with interest according to the rate of interest above mentioned, then and from thenceforth the presents shall be utterly null and void anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise notwithstanding. And it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties to these presents, that until default, shall be made in payment, of the aforesaid sum, as before set forth and the interest for the same, it shall be lawful to and for the said John B Smith to peaceably and quietly to hold use occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and released and every part thereof with the appurtenances, and to have receive and take the rents, issues and profits thereof to his own particular use and behoof, anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
