Know all men by these presents that I Wicajah Jordan of the State and District of Georgia in consideration of nine hundred and sixty eight \$900 Dollars to me paid by Palas E Jordan of the same place, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Palas E Jordan all that plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred and sixty seven acres (more or less) situate in the District aforesaid on the waters of Mountain Creek. Beginning on a Pinesimmon 3, on Coolidge bridge road and running thence S 42° 0' 15.70 to a Stake 3, thence S 73° 0' 14.70 to a stake 3, bounded by Wicajah Jordan, thence S 12° 0' 21.87 to a Pinesimmon 3, bounded by James M Cullough, thence N 75° 0' 37.54 to a Post Oak 3, thence N 39° 0' 1.45 to a Post Oak 3, thence N 43° 0' 22.20 to a Red Oak 3, thence N 42° 0' 41.70 to a White Oak stump 3, bounded by Jesse French, thence N 82° 0' 29.54 to a Stone 3, bounded by Anthony David, thence N 4° 0' 10.85 to a Stone 3, on said Road, bounded by Henry Stokes, thence a N E course along said road 65 chains to the beginning, bounded by the said Wicajah Jordan.

Together with all and singular the rights, liberties, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the same belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Palas E Jordan his heirs I assign forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Palas E Jordan his heirs and assigns against myself, and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
