Know all men by these presents, that we Henry
^{Malars} and Elizabeth Malars (wife) of Guilford Dis-
trict in the State of aforesaid, in considera-

tion of Five dollars to us in hand paid by John W. Goddard of Guil-
ford District in the State of aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold, re-
leased and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the
said John W. Goddard all our right, title, and interest (as legates) in
a certain tract or parcel of Land situate, lying and being in the Dis-
trict and State of aforesaid on waters of North Saluda River joining
lands of John Cox, William Lynche & others containing one hundred
acres more or less, it being a tract of Land purchased by John
Shelton from Isaac Ford by a deed of conveyance dated the
15th day of Novr 1625.

Together with all and singular the rights, members
hereditaments and appertanances to the said premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining; So have and do we do
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John
W. Goddard his heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby bind our
selves, our heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and fore-
