This indenture made the 17th seventeenth
day of July Eighteen hundred and fifty

five between Aspasio Earle of the County and State aforesaid &
Mary McCarle his wife, of the one part, and William Edward Earle
& Mary McCarle son & daughter of Aspasio and Mary Earle
son Henry McCarle of the other part at this time living in the
State of South Carolina, Witnesseth that the aforesaid Aspasio
Earle and Mary Earle his wife for and in consideration of the
natural love and affection which they have and bear unto the said
Grande children William E. Earle & Mary McCarle, have given
and granted aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these
presents do give grant, alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said
William E. Earle and Mary McCarle live negroes, namely 5 of plus
and Vina that are now part of my family of Blacks, the boy
Dolphus to William E. Earle and Vina to Mary McCarle.
