situate and being in the Town of Greenville in the Carolina on Broadwater Street  
Street and near the Female Baptist College and adjoining the lot of 7 lot of  
Henry Stokes, containing about one acre and three quarters of an acre District  
Beginning on a Stake near the Broadwater Street and runs thence along the edge or lip  
of said Street North 38 1/2 West 212 feet to a Stake on the Avenue or Street leading  
from the said Baptist Female College and runs thence along the line leading
