To have and to hold all and singular the Premises herein mentioned unto the said Wm J. & I Wm Glenn their heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Wm J. & I Wm Glenn their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
