Know all men by these presents That I Charles J Garrison of Greenwell District in the aforesaid State in consideration of Sixteen hundred Dollars to me paid by John Westfield of Greenwell District in the State aforesaid have Granted, Bargained Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the said John Westfield all my right, Title, interest and estate (being one half thereof) in a certain tract of land lying situate and being in the District and State aforesaid on the Augusta Road about nine miles below Greenwell Court House, containing Six hundred and thirty five acres more or less bounded and described as follows Beginning at a Pine on the road running S 64 E 22. To a pine at the head of a branch thence with said branch to a Stake corner thence S 43 E 57.50 with the land and line of a small branch to a Stake thence S 44 W 77.75 across two branches to a Spanish oak thence N 27 W 19 to a White oak on a branch thence N 28 W 29.75 up the branch to a Sassafras thence N 45 E 5 to a corner thence N 28 W 31 to a Water oak on the branch thence N 17 W 14.50 up the branch to a Black Gum thence S 50 W 16.50 across the road to a Red Oak thence N 2 W 3.50 to a Red oak on the road to General Garrison's Mill thence N 38 W 36 to a Red oak across a small branch and thence N 71 E 39 to the beginning pine corner

Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining I do hereby give and sell unto the said John Westfield his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said John Westfield his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claim of any person lawfully claiming or to claim the same at any part thereof
