of Eight hundred dollars to him paid by Elijah Eskew of Greenville district  
and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and  
they present do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Elijah  
Eskew all that that a piece of Land situate in the District aforesaid on  
the North East side of Saluda River Beginning on a stone corner stone at  
22 E 35 ch to a Stake 3<sup>x</sup> Thence N 42 E 35 to a Stake 3<sup>x</sup> Thence N 42 E  
19 to Park east stamp. Thence N 80 W 30 ch to a Stake. Thence S 30 W 10 ch  
to a Stake. Thence N 80 W 28 ch to a Stake. Thence N 31 E 1 ch to Stake then  
N 80 W 17 ch to a Stake. Thence S 18 W 54 p 50 to a Stake on the River then  
down river River to a hickory below the mouth of Russell Spring Branch  
Thence N 73 E 3 ch to a white oak Stake S 26 E 24 ch to the beginning  
corner

Together with all and singular the rights, members, inhabitants  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident  
or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before

I do hereby lease & grant my heirs Executors and Administrators to

or any part thereof.
