Know all men by these presents that I John Westford of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of the one hundred and eighty three to me in hand paid by Charles Garrison of the State and District have bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Charles Garrison a certain piece of land containing thirty and a half acres (be the same more or less) situated in Granville District on the branches of Golden Grove Creek waters of Saluda River and hath such courses from one mark to a plat well represented beginning on stake on the branch thence down the said branch to stake 37x30 thence N 45° E 35 to black gum 37x30 thence N 45° E 8° to stake 31 new thence S 75° W 27 to stone on the Weldon Ferry road thence S 89° W 17 to the beginning State 3451 It being a part of the tract of land known as the tea farm originally owned by J. Smith bounded by lands of Charles Garrison, Bernack Garrison and others.

For the with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said Charles Garrison his heirs and assigns forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Charles Garrison his heirs Executors and Administrators against myself my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim every part thereof.
