Witness all present that we

Jesus French and his wife Martha French  
of Greenville District in the aforesaid State for ever in consideration of the sum of  
Five hundred and eighty Dollars to us paid by Lawrence Lenhardt of  
Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and delivered  
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the Lawrence Lenhardt  
all that piece, parcel and tract of Land Containing Fifty eight acres  
more or less being the same tract upon which Mordica M. Smith resided at  
his death and being the same tract Mordica M. Smith the purchased from him  
by deed bearing date 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 1853 situate lying and being in  
the District and State aforesaid about 4 1/4 miles from the Town of Greenville and upon  
the Greenville and Columbia Rail Road Beginning at a Stake 3<sup>rd</sup> middle of said  
Rail Road runs thence due East 11.60 chains to a Stake 3<sup>rd</sup> on a Branch, head waters  
of the Golden Grove Stream up the meanders of said Branch to a Stake 3<sup>rd</sup> near a  
Pine tree on the right bank Stream A 31 E 5.30 chs to a Sp 0 3<sup>rd</sup> Lawrence Lenhardt  
corner Stream with Lenhardt line S 81 E 14.94 chains to a Stake 3<sup>rd</sup> Stream A 05  
E 24.60 chs to a Stake 3<sup>rd</sup> on old line Stream with old line N 70 W 18.37 chs to a  
Stake near a road Stream down the middle of s<sup>d</sup> road 11.25 chs to a Stake 3<sup>rd</sup> in  
said road Stream N 70.45 W 5.78 chs to a Stake 3<sup>rd</sup> in middle of old Rail road  
Stream down the center of s<sup>d</sup> Rail Road 24.55 1/2 chs beginning Stake corner

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Tools  
Tenants and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise  
incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said Lawrence Lenhardt his heirs and assigns  
forever And we do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs executors and adm  
itors to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises  
unto the said Lawrence Lenhardt his heirs and assigns against us and our  
heirs and against any person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or  
to claim the same or any part thereof

year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America
