Whereas Mandocia McSmith late of Summerville District in the State of South Carolina sometime deceased left his wife or widow Mrs Althea A. Smith, his son Henry Smith and his brother Artemas Hobsmill and whereas the said parties being all of full age it has been between them to make partition and division amongst them of the said Real and personal Estates which is the tract of Land herein after mentioned and conveyed and leaving as his heirs at Law, his widow Mrs Althea A. Smith, his son Henry Smith and his brother Artemas Hobsmill and whereas the said parties being all of full age it has been between them to make partition and division amongst them of the said Real and personal Estates so left by the Mandocia McSmith without the intervention of a Court of Equity for the division of the said Real Estates and whereas in the said agreement for division the said Henry Smith is to take the Tract of Land herein after described and conveyed at and for the sum and price of Eight Hundred Dollars as to move towards the payment of his share in the said Real and personal Estates of the said Mandocia McSmith deceased Now all morally these presents that in consideration of the said sum of Eight Hundred Dollars to us by the said Henry Smith so paid me the said Althea A. Smith and Artemas Hobsmill have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Henry Smith all that piece, place and tract of land called the Hunt Tract containing Two Hundred Acres more or less situate lying and being in the District of Greenville in the State of South Carolina the waters of the Little Sandy Fork of Sandy River adjoining lands of Samuel Moore by John Sullivan Esq. & Henry Hopkins late holding the same Tract of land conveyed and described in a Deed from William Harte to Mandocia McSmith dated March 14<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1842 to which reference is truly made for a particular description of the lines and boundaries.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, appendages to the said premises belonging or in any wise included or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said Henry Smith his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and from defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry Smith his heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

Witness our hands and seals this the twenty ninth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty four and in the 80<sup>th</sup> year of the Independence of the United States of America.
