to make partition and division amongst them of the said Real and Personal
estates so left by the said Mordicai M. Smith without the intervention of a
Court of Equity for the division of the said Real Estate and wheras in the
said agreement upon division the said Artomas H. Smith is to take the tract
of land herein after described and conveyed unto him for the sum of and
perce of Six Thousand and Twelve dollars and fifty cents as so much toward
the payment of his share in the said Real and Personal Estates of the
said Mordicai M. Smith deceased

I now witness all meny these presents that in
consideration of the said sum of Six Thousand and Twelve dollars and fifty
cents to us by the said Artomas H. Smith unpaid the said Althea & Smith and
Henry Smith have granted, bargained sold and released unto these presents
do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Artomas H. Smith all that piece
parcel and tract of land containing one hundred and twenty two and a half
acres more or less situate lying and being in the District of Greenville in the State
of South Carolina branches of the South Reedy Fork of Reedy River which
was conveyed to the said Mordicai M. Smith deceased in his life time by
Henry Smith as Executor of the last will and Testament of William May
deceased and is fully described in the deed for the same from Henry Smith
to Mordicai M. Smith bearing date the 4th day of April A.D. 1853.
