of the State and District aforesaid did by his Last Will and Testament dated the 23^d of June A.D. 1827 Leave a Tract of Land to his wife during her Life ~~and~~ at her death to be sold by his Executors for distribution amongst her heirs now I Micajah Berry surviving Executor did sell the said Tract of Land to Isaac Devenport of the State and District aforesaid he being the highest bidder at a sale legally advertised on the 12th day of December 1849 for five hundred Dollars and in consideration of said sum of Five hundred Dollars and in accordance with said will Micajah Berry Executor of said will as aforesaid do hereby transfer and convey to the said Isaac Devenport all the right and title the said William Nea ~~had~~ had to said Tract of Land ~~it~~ Lying in the State and District aforesaid on the branches of Horse Creek waters of Needy River containing one hundred and two acres be the same more or less including the house and plantation whereas the said William Nea lived at his death and whereas the Widow lived and died Beginning on a white oak corner thence Running N 57^o E 62.50 to a stake bounded by William Andersons and Jas Andersons thence S 44^o E 6.41 to a stone bounded by William Nea junr and Mrs Bolling thence S 33^o W 27 to a stake bounded by Mrs Bolling thence N 40^o W 32 to a stone & still bounded by
