Decd South Carolina ⁶⁴⁷ I know all
To Greenville District men by these
Land presents that I Vardry McBee of

the Village of Greenville and State
of South Carolina for me in consideration of the sum of three
Hundred and Twenty five dollars to me paid by Fair P Smith
is of the same State and District have this day granted bargained
and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto
the said Fair P Smith a certain tract or parcel of Land lying
hom in Greenville District on Needy River on the opposite side from
in Adams Mill containing Sixty Two and One half acres
and be the same more or less beginning on a Black Oak tree on the
east side of the River and runs thence North 66° E 35' chas
ed along Mr Dacus line to a Black Oak tree thence N 28 W 18.90 to a
dogwood 34 on or near Clarks line thence S 50 W 47' claims to a corn
in the River Bank near a large Rock thence down the meanders
of the River to the Beginning corner see plat made by A. T. Morris
^{3rd April 1848} the said land having been sold by the Sheriff of
Greenville District as the property of John Bramlett dec'd and
purchased by me. Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditament and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the said premises
with their appurtenances unto the said Fair P Smith
his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my
self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and
forever defend the aforesaid premises with their appurtenances
unto the said Fair P Smith his heirs and assigns against
me and my heirs and against every other person or persons who
soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part there
of witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
11th day of May 1835 Vardry McBee
