 self my heirs Executors and Administrators and every of them firmly by
 these presents sealed with my seal and dated this Twentieth sixth day of
 August in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and
 fifty six (1856) The condition of this obligation is such that if the above
 bounded Thomas S Arther shall on or before the first day of January One
 thousand Eight hundred & sixty two make execute and deliver into
 the said Alex and Greenfield Trustee as aforesaid his successors or
 assigns provided that the said Alexander Greenfield Trustee as aforesaid
 or his successors or assigns shall on or before the day last mentioned have
 paid or caused to be paid to the above bounded Alex the sum of Five
 thousand & two hundred Dollars in six several notes or bonds as follows
 One of Five hundred Dollars due on or before the first day of January One
 thousand Eight hundred and fifty seven and five other notes or bonds
 of Five hundred & forty Dollars each due respectively on or before the first
 day of each January succeeding the last mentioned the last of said notes
 or bonds payable on or before the 1st day of January One thousand Eight
 hundred & sixty two each and every of said notes being dated the Twentieth
 sixth day of August in the year One thousand Eight hundred and fifty
 six (the date of these presents) and bearing interest from the first day
 of November next after the date of this instrument and signed by the
 said Alexander Greenfield Trustee and by Robert Greenfield as security for
 said notes or bonds being the price of a amount of purchase money agreed
 to be paid therefor in good and sufficient conveyance freed from all
 incumbrances and for the sole and separate use benefit & behoof of the aforesaid
 said Mary C Greenfield freed from the debts contracts or liabilities of
 her present or any future husband of all that tract or parcel of land
 situated here and being in Greenville District aforesaid about three miles
 from Greenville Court House on Brushy creek adjoining land
 of William Jacobs & Vardry & Co and containing one thousand
 and fifty three Acres be the same more or less and on which are
 a Tan Wood & Mills. And also if the said Thomas S Arther his
 Executors and administrators and assigns or either of them do or shall
 permit and suffer the said Alexander Greenfield Trustee as aforesaid
 for the use and trusts aforesaid to have occupy and enjoy for the
 use and benefit of the said Mrs Mary C Greenfield all and singular
 the premises above mentioned and every part and parcel thereof without
 any manner of let hinderance or disturbance of the said Thomas S
