as one standing and it is covenanted and agreed upon by and between the parties
to these presents that until default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid
sum as before set forth with interest for the same it shall and may be
lawful to and for the said James B Hill peaceably and quietly to hold use
occupy possess and enjoy all and singular the premises above granted and
release and every part thereof with the appurtenances and to have receive
and take the rents issues and profits thereof to his own particular use and
enjoyment. Anything herein contained to the contrary, hereof in any wise notwithstanding
