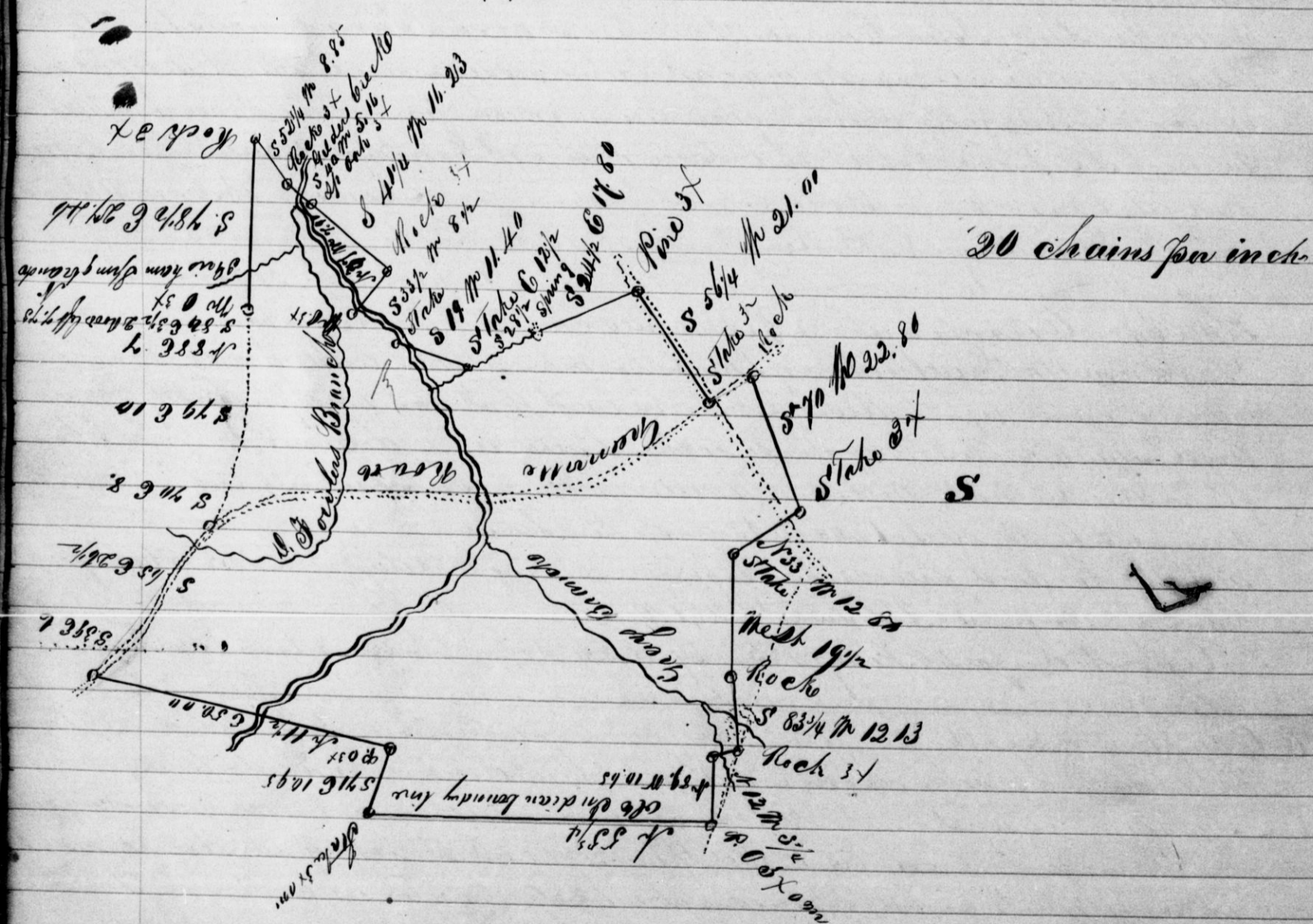

District aforesaid having Granted bargained and sold and by
these presents do grant bargain and sell and release unto the
said John Campbell a certain lot or parcel of land lying and being
in the district of aforesaid beginning on a post oak running S 76 E 4
to chains to a stake at the stone thence N 43 W 7.33 ch to a post oak
thence S 6 E 6.35 ch to the beginning corner containing by estimat-
ion One acre and One fourth more or less it being a part of
a tract of land deeded to Randal Barnett by Martin Oats to have
and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto
the said John Campbell I do hereby bind my self my heirs executors
administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the above premises
unto the said John Campbell his heirs executors administrators &
assigns against my self my heirs and assigns and against any person
or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part of the same in witness
whereof I set my hand and seal of this 1st December 1856 Signed Sealed

of Four thousand and fifty dollars & 50 cents bearing date January
the twenty ninth One thousand eight hundred and fifty seven
due at twelve months with interest from date together with all
and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances
