

aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of seventy five Dollars to me in hand paid by John Campbell of the District aforesaid having Granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and release unto the said John Campbell a certain lot or parcel of land lying and being in the district of aforesaid beginning a post oak running N 76 E 40 chains to a Stake at the stone thence N 43 W 7.33 ch to a post oak thence S 87 E 6.35 ch to the beginning corner containing by estimation One Acre and one fourth more or less it being a part of a tract of land deeded to Randal Barnett by Martin oats token and to hold all and singular the premises abovementioned unto the said John Campbell I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the above premises unto the said John Campbell his heirs executors administrators & assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and garnet any person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part of the same in witness whereof I set my hand and seal of this 1<sup>st</sup> December 1836 signed sealed and delivered in presents
