 of the sum of Ten dollars to me paid by Ira C Williams of the said  
 State and District have given granted bargained sold and  
 delivered, and by these presents do hereby give grant bargain  
 sell and deliver to the said Ira C Williams the following slaves  
 to wit a negro boy named Henry about eleven years of age, a  
 negro woman named Rachel about forty four years of age, a negro  
 Boy Bowman aged about six years child of Rachel a negro man  
 named Dick about thirty four years of age and a negro girl  
 named Harriet, about eighteen years of age, and their increase  
 in trust for and to the special use and benefit of my said wife  
 Francis L Williams for and during the term of her natural  
 life and at her death then in trust for and to the special  
 use and benefit of the the children of the said Francis L  
 Williams and myself and their heirs forever to have and to

and to hold the said slaves Henry Rachel Bowman Dick and Har-  
 riet unto the said Ira C Williams Trustee as aforesaid and  
 his heirs forever in trust for and to the special use and  
 benefit of my said wife Francis L Williams for and during the  
 term of her natural life, and at her death then in trust for  
 and to the special use and benefit of the children of the said  
 Francis L Williams and my self the joint issue of our bodies as  
 aforesaid and their heirs forever and to suffer my said wife and  
 her children as aforesaid to enjoy the use and profit of the said
