56 David Hoke Deed To Waddy Thompson Land For The State of South Carolina To all whom these presents shall come

J. D. Hoke Sheriff of Greenville District and State aforesaid send greeting. Whereas by Virtue of a Writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville tested the twenty fourth day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty six at the Suit of Lemuel S. Hudson to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of John Mc Jones to levy the sum of Eleven thousand six hundred & twenty Dollars & fifty five cents damages and cost I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said John Mc Jones all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing sixty two acres more or less situate and being in the District of Greenville on the East side of the Rutherford Road one and a half miles from the Village of Greenville adjoining lands of Dr C. B. Stone Dr John Crittenden Mrs Emily Rowland also eight acres of land lying in Greenville District on the East side of the Rutherford road adjoining the above tract also five acres of land situate lying in the District of Greenville on the East side of the Rutherford Road adjoining lands of Dr John Crittenden and Mrs Emily Rowland and whereas the said premises with their appurtenances since the the seizure by me made by Virtue of the said Writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at public Vendue and purchased by Waddy Thompson of the District of Greenville for the sum of Forty three thousand and three Dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor. Now know ye that I David Hoke Sheriff aforesaid by Virtue of the said Writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by Virtue of the Statute in such cases made and provided and for and in consideration of the said sum of Forty three thousand and three Dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Waddy Thompson the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which John Mc Jones of right had of in and to the same To Have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said David

Hoke Sheriff might could or ought to grant bargain and sell the same by Virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said Writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise. 57 Robert McKay Deed To Oliver Strammell Land State of South Carolina Greenville District This indenture made this second day of March in the year

of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty seven between Robert McKay ordinary of the District aforesaid and Oliver Strammell of the same State and District Whereas a Writ of Summons to divide or sell a certain tract of land hereinafter described of the Estate of James Picket of said District deceased issued from the Court of ordinary of said District and upon the return thereof the Judges of said Court did determine that the said land could be divided without injury to the parties interested and did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the District aforesaid did advertise the said land for sale on the first Monday in March in the year above mentioned and whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on the said day expose to sale at public outcry on the credit aforesaid the said land when the said Oliver Strammell was the last and highest bidder to whom the said Land was struck off for the sum of Two hundred and sixty five Dollars. Now this indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of Two thousand and sixty five Dollars to me paid and secured to be paid I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Oliver Strammell and his heirs and assigns forever all that tract of Land situated in said District lying on both sides of Weirs Creek adjoining lands of John Hawkins dec John W.
