eight hundred and fifty six between Robt McKay ordinary of the District aforesaid and Sandy J Goodlett of the same State and District. Whereas a Writ of Summons to divide or sell a certain tract of Land hereinafter described of the estate of Eli Alewine of said District deceased issued from the Court of Ordins of said District and upon the return thereof the Judge of said Court did determine that the said land could not be divided without injury to the parties interested and did order the same to be sold by the Sheriff of the District aforesaid on a credit of twelve months with interest from day of Sale. Whereupon the Sheriff aforesaid did advertise the said Land for Sale on the first Monday in November in the year above mentioned. and Whereas the Sheriff aforesaid did on the said day expose to sale at public outcry on the credit aforesaid the said Land when the said Sandy J Goodlett was the last and highest bidder to whom the said Land was struck off for the sum of One Hundred and eighty Two Dollars. Now this indenture Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of one hundred and Eighty Two Dollars to me paid. and secured to be paid. I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Sandy J Goodlett and his heirs and assigns forever all that Tract of Land situated in said District on waters of Smiths Tiger River bounded by Lands of Elijah Dill Thomas Chandler Tidewell John J Goodlett Andrew Adam and by a tract of Land belonging to Estate Eli Alewine and purchased by Eli Carny containing One hundred and Eighty Two and three fourth acres reference to a Plot filed in the papers in the ordinarys office will more fully explain the boundanes. Together with the appurtenances thereto belonging and all the estate right title interest claim or demand which the said Eli Alewine deceased at the time of his death had in or to the same. To have and to hold the said Tract of Land together with all and singular the premises improvements and appurtenances to the said Sandy J Goodlett his heirs and assigns forever. Miller of the State and District aforesaid in consideration of the natural love and affection I bear to my daughter Louisa Caroline Smith have given granted and bargained and by these presents do give grant and bequeath unto the said Louisa Caroline Smith that tract of land laid off for her being part of the original survey of Cha Dean & Moses Langly containing One hundred acres more or less beginning at a Rock at Rocky Creek thence S 80 W 16.60 to a Stake Cor. Thence S 13 W 28 1/2 ch to a Stake on S Hamby's land thence with Hamby's land S 33 E 50 ch to a rock Cor. Thence N 42 E. a new line dividing it from G Miller's land 50 ch to a poplar Cor at the Creek thence up said creek 11 ch to the beginning Cor. on inspection of the plat annexed will more fully appear. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold full and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Louisa Caroline Smith her heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my self & my heirs to warrant and forever defend all the premises before mentioned unto the said Louisa Caroline Smith her heirs and assigns against the claim of any person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
