 Whereas the said Samuel Payne did sell the same to his Mother Mrs
 Susanna Payne and she having died before titles were made to her or
 the Purchase Money paid and the said Samuel Payne having filed a
 Bill in the Court of Equity for the Settlement of the real Estate of the said
 Aaron Payne deceased and for relief and Made the heirs of said Aaron
 Payne deceased parties dependant to said Bill and the said Court of Equity
 at Greenville July Term 1836 did by decree on said Bill amongst
 other things order and direct the said Sale to Mrs Susanna Payne to be set
 aside and otherwise the said Samuel Payne to sell the Land of the said Aaron
 Payne below decreed accordingly after due advertisement the said Samuel
 Payne on the sixth day of October 1836 sold the said Land at public and
 auction to James M. McDaniel for the sum of fifteen hundred and fifty
 Dollars he being the highest bidder at that price now therefore in
 Consideration of the premises and in Consideration of the sum of fifteen
 hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by the said James M.
 McDaniel the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged I the said Samuel
 Payne Executor as aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and
 by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 James M. McDaniel his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of
 Land of the Estate of the said Aaron Payne deceased situated lying and
 being in Greenville District and State aforesaid on waters of Golden
 Grove Creek containing by Measure about three hundred and fourteen
 acres two rods and twenty four poles more or less adjoining Lands of Mary
 Lewis my self, John Smith and Cleaveland and others being the said
 whereas the said Aaron Payne deceased lived at his death having and accepting
 from this Conveyance and reserving unto the said Samuel Payne one
 acre of said tract including the family Grave yard with right of way
 thereto the said tract of Land having such form and shape courses and
 distances and boundaries as are exhibited by a plot of the same heretofore
 unrescued made and certified by W. D. Threlkeld C. S. 25 November 1833
 Together with all and singular the rights members servitudes and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid
 unto the said James M. McDaniel his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the
 said James M. McDaniel his heirs and assigns against me and
 my heirs and against all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming
 or to claim the same or any part thereof by or through me or by
 and through the heirs and representatives of the said Aaron Payne
 and Susanna Payne deceased witness my hand and

Come I I Woke Sheriff of Greenville
 District and State aforesaid send greeting Whereas by virtue
 of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas
 held for the District of Anderson tested the fourteenth day of
 June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and fifty five at the suit of Bancroft Betts and Marshall
 to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels
 lands and tenements of William Stone to Levy the sum of
 damages and cost I have seized and taken
 of the lands and tenements of the said William Stone all that
 certain piece parcel and tract of Land containing two hun-
 dred acres more or less situate and being in the District of
 Greenville in two miles of Chickets Springs adjoining lands George
 W. King and others. Now Know ye that the said premises with
 their appurtenances since the seizure by me made by virtue
 of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned have been
 exposed to sale at public vendue and purchased by Robert Wynn
 of the District of Greenville for the sum of Five Hundred and
 fifty five Dollars being the highest sum that was bidden there-
 for. Now Know ye that I I Woke Sheriff aforesaid by virtue
 of the said writ of Fieri facias aforesaid to me directed and
 delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such
 case made and provided and for and in consideration of the
 sum of Five Hundred and fifty five Dollars to me in hand
 paid or secured to be paid by the said Robert Wynn the receipt
 and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and
 sell unto the said Robert Wynn his heirs and assigns forever the
 said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and
 all the estate right title and interest which the said William
 Stone of right had of in and to the same To have and to hold
 the said piece parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances
