Walker of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of Eighteen hundred Dollars to me paid by foab Mauldin of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said foab Mauldin all that piece parcel and lot of Land containing Two and One third acre more or less situate lying and being in the Town of Greenville in the District and State aforesaid and having the following lines metes and bounds viz beginning at a Stake on Avenue Street opposite Merricks 1 & corner and running thence with Avenue Street two hundred and sixty feet to a Stake opposite Wallace Doors 1 & corner, thence with a 40 feet lot running between this lot and Doors three hundred and forty six feet to a Stake on Washington Street thence with Washington Street two hundred and sixty one feet to a Stake opposite J. W. Brooks 1 & corner thence with a street between this and Brooks lots three hundred and fifty feet to the beginning. This being the same lot conveyed to me by Waddy Thompson by Deed of November 8<sup>th</sup> 1854.
