bargain sell and release unto the said William D Mayfield all that
tract or parcel of land situate and being in the District and
State aforesaid on the South Side of South Tyger River Beginning
at a Maple 3+ on said river and runs S 49 E 19.46 to a Stone 3+
in an old field thence S 8 1/2 E 17.40 to a Post Oak 3+ dead thence S 71
W 7.80 to a Stone 3+ thence South 25.00 to a Stone 3+ thence S 64 E 19.30 to
a Cherry tree 3+ on the District Line. Thence with said Line N 1/4
W 55.38 to a small Red Oak 3+ dead and down and Pine Stump thence
S 38 1/2 W 8.30 to a Poplar 3+ 3+ in the head of a branch. Thence N 21 1/4 W 31
