 of land situate between the Augusta and Anderson roads about one  
 mile from Greenville C. H. Beginning at a P.O. known as old Jacks corner  
 and runs thence with LaBrucers line S 15 W 45 chs to a Stake formerly  
 a pine stump thence with Wesley Brooks line S 65 W 16.50 chs to a Stake  
 near or in a small branch thence up said branch N 14 W 11 chs to a Stake  
 & near the edge of the branch swamp thence N 34 W about two hundred  
 (200) feet to the Rail Road line thence a long said Rail Road line  
 about One hundred & eighty yards (180 yds) on Sandy Walkers old line  
 thence with the said Walkers line S 72 E 11.50 chs to a Red O.S. & thence  
 64 chs 25 links to Jacks corner thence with Jacks line S 15 W 525 to a  
 Rock & thence 64 chs to the begining P.O. & Containing about twenty acres  
 more or less being a part of 24 acres conveyed to R B Duncan by Cardy
