the said Thomas B Roberts the Receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged hath granted Bargained sold and Released and
by these Presents doth grant Bargain sell and release unto
the said Thomas B Roberts Heirs and assigns all that tract
lot and parcel of Land lying and being Situate in the
Town of Greenville District and state aforesaid known
and Described as follows by a recent Survey and Plat of the
same made by John Watson District Surveyor to wit, beginning
at a stake on Browns Alley On Clevelands Lot running thence
along said Alley N. 16. E. 100. feet to a stake on Thomas Street
Lot. thence S. 74. E. 200 feet to a stake on Spring Street thun-
ce along said street S. 16. W. 100 feet to a stake thence N. 74.
W. 200 feet to the beginning known as Lot W. 13. in McBees
Plan made by Barrillon together with all and singular
the Hereditaments Rights Members and appurtenances whatsoever
to the said Real Estate belonging or in anywise appertaining
