

H. W. Huller Deed *The State of South Carolina*
 To *Land* Know all men by these presents
A. McKinney That *H. W. Huller* of the District
 of *Greenville* in the State aforesaid
 for and in consideration of the sum of *Five Hundred Dollars*
 to me in hand paid by *Alexander McKinney* of the District of
Greenville in the State aforesaid have granted bargained
 and sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said *Alexander McKinney* all that
 tract or parcels of *Land* containing *one Hundred and Fourteen*
acres more or less situated in the District of *Greenville* in the State
 aforesaid on the head water of *Syger River* and it being two Strips
 of *Land* the first conveyed to me by *John Brisson* by Deed bearing
 date the *28th* day of *October 1853* and the other conveyed to me
 by *W. H. Watson* this day which *Land* was conveyed to him by *Mason*
Saylor Sheriff of *Greenville* District by deed bearing date the *19th*
 day of *December* in the year *1848*, and sold as the property of *Sehul*
Bradley and runs as follows beginning at a *red oak 3+* down *N 7 W*
40 1/2 chains to a *stake* thence *S 6 W 30 00* chains to a *Black Gum 3+* thence
S 20 1/2 E 45 00 chains to a *stake 3+* thence along said *Alexander McKinney*
 line to the beginning and ^{being} a tract of *land* surveyed for *Levi Carey*
 the *3rd* day of *May 1785* and bounded by lands of said *Alexander*
McKinney *James McKinney* and myself and *Benjamin Colley*
 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said *Alexander McKinney* his heirs and
 assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
 and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
 singular the said premises unto the said *Alexander McKinney*
 his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other
 person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any
 part thereof Witness my hand and seal this the *fifth* day
 of *January* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-
 dred and *Fifty Eight* and in the *Eighty Second* year of the

Daniel Cockram day of *August* in the year of our
 Lord One thousand Eight hundred
 and fifty seven between *John W. Grady* of the one Part and
Daniel Cockram of the other Part witnesseth: whereon
 the said *John W. Grady* hath made and delivered his
 bond bearing even date herewith to the said *Daniel Cock-*
ram in the sum of *Fifteen hundred Dollars* with a condition
 therein conveyed that the said *John W. Grady* shall well
 and truly keep and perform a certain agreement between
 him and the said *Daniel Cockram* therein alluded to
 which concerns the Purchase of certain Slaves by the said
John W. Grady of the said *Daniel* as will run fully appear
 by reference and said Bond Now this indenture witness-
 eth that the said *John W. Grady* for and in consideration
 of the sum of *five Dollars* to the said *John W. Grady*
 by the said *Daniel Cockram* in hand Paid at and
 before the selling and delivery of these presents have granted
 bargained sold and released and by these presents do
 grant bargain sell and release unto the said *Daniel*
Cockram all that Lot of *Land* in the Town of *Greenville*
South Carolina situated on the South East corner of the public
 Square being the Lot whereon I now reside and which I
 purchased from *G. F. Townes* and which was conveyed to
 me by him together with all and singular the Rights Members
 Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises
 belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have
 and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned
 unto the said *Daniel Cockram* his heirs and assigns
 forever and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors
 and Administrators to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said Premises unto the said
Daniel Cockram his heirs and assigns against me and
 my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any Part thereof
 Provided always Nevertheless and it is the true intent &
 meaning of the Parties to these presents that if the said
John W. Grady his heirs executors or administrators shall
 well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said
Daniel Cockram the sum of *Fifteen hundred Dollars*
 according to the Bond above mentioned then and from
 thenceforth these presents shall be utterly null and void any-
 thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in anywise
 notwithstanding and it is covenanted and agreed upon
 by all between the Parties to these presents that until
 default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid
 sum as before set forth and the interest for the same
 it shall and may be lawful to and for the said
