

William Barton Deed the State of South Carolina
 To Joseph Barton Land For Know all men by these presents that
 Whereas Alfred Cantrell on the thirty first day
 of January and the seventh day of February
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty three
 by his this two deeds in writing under his hand and seal duly recorded
 in the Clerks office of Greenville District in Book W page 683 the 24th
 January 1854 and the other page W 687 and 688 the 25th day of February
 1854 for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred and sixty
 five dollars to him in hand paid by Joseph and William Barton
 did grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Joseph and
 William Barton jointly certain plantations or parcels of land on
 both sides of Beaber dam creek waters of North Saluda river in
 the District of Greenville and State aforesaid containing four hundred
 and eighty acres in both tracts more or less bounded as by
 reference to the said deeds may appear. Now know ye that the
 said William Barton in order to make division and partition of the
 said tracts of lands between my self and the said Joseph Barton
 have for and in consideration of the sum of six hundred and
 fifty dollars to me in hand paid by the said Joseph Barton have
 granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph Barton all my right
 title interest claim and demand whatsoever of in or to all and
 singular my part of the tract of land above mentioned to have and
 to hold the above mentioned premises unto the said Joseph Barton
 his heirs and assigns from me and my heirs and from no other person
 or persons whomsoever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs
 Executors and administrators to quit claim the above described
 premises unto the said Joseph Barton unto his heirs and assigns
 and no further and the intent and meaning I am only to
 warrant and forever defend the above from me and my heirs
 and assigns and no further. In witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal this first day of December Eighteen hundred

 To J B Bissell Land For Greenville District
 Know all men by these presents that
 I John Crittenden of the District and
 State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred
 and fifteen dollars and twenty three cents to me in hand paid by
 John Bennett Bissell of Charleston South Carolina the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargain sold and
 released and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain release
 and convey unto the said John Bennett Bissell all that piece and lot
 of land situate lying and being in the district of Greenville and State
 of South Carolina on Richland Creek waters of Needy river contain-
 ing as appears by a plat made by John C Hoyt Esquire Deputy Surveyor
 on the 18th day of February 1858 bounded as follows beginning at a red oak
 running thence S 25 West one chain 90 links to a stake thence S 45 West 9
 chains 60 links to a stake thence north 61 East 8 chains to a stake thence
 south 19 East 2 chains 45 links to a stake thence south 3 west 6 chains
 25 links to a gum thence south 84 W 25 links to the beginning contain-
 ing four and a half acres more or less. Together with all and singular
 the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging
 or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and
 singular the the premises before mentioned and described unto the said
 John Bennett Bissell his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby
 bind my self my heirs executors administrators and assigns to warrant
 and defend all and singular the aforesaid lot of land unto the said John
 Bennett Bissell his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and
 against every other person whomsoever claiming or to claim the aforesaid
