in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand
three hundred and forty Dollars to us in hand paid by Andrew S Stone
of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargain
sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said Andrew S Stone all that piece parcel and tract of land
whom the said Banister Stone deceased lived at the time of his
death containing seven hundred and fifty three acres more or less
situate being and lying within the District of Greenville and State
aforesaid upon Horse Pen Creek and designated by the following
marks and boundaries Viz Beginning at a pine 3+3+ at the head
of a branch running N 77° W 6.67 to Post oak 3+3+3+ dead on the line
