 David Devenport Land that I Leonard Cagle of Greenville
 District in the State aforesaid in
 consideration of Five thousand Dollars to me paid by
 David Devenport formerly of North Carolina now of Green-
 ville District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained
 sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and release unto the said David Devenport all that tract
 or parcel of land situate lying & being in Greenville District
 South Carolina on the middle fork of Saluda River known
 as the McKenny tract of Land containing Five hundred
 & forty Acres more or Less bounded as follows, beginning on a
 Stake, thence N 35 E 110 chains to a Post oak 34 thence N 60 W
 46 chains to a spy corner thence S 65 W 4 chains crossing the
 middle fork of Saluda River to a dogwood thence to a
 chestnut thence to a Sweet Gum, thence to a Beach thence to
 a Red Oak, thence to a dogwood, thence S 35 W 41.50 chains
 to a Hickory thence S 55 E 11 chains to a white oak thence S 35
 W 28 chains to a Stake thence S 45 E 10 chains to a Hickory, thence
 S 35 W 24 chains to a Post Oak thence S 35 E 35 chains to the
 Beginning, Together with all and singular the rights Members
 Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
 or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to
 hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said David Devenport his heirs and assigns
 and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and
 administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
 singular the said premises unto the said David Deven-
 port his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs
 and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to

 ing One hundred acres more or less, Beginning at a Black
 oak corner on Burns land & running thence S 55 E 17.50 to a
 large white oak, thence S 22 W 17 to a Black Gum thence to
 a Spanish Oak thence straight course to the beginning
 corner adjoining lands of James Burns & others, Together
 with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments
 and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in
 anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said David Devenport his heirs and assigns forever and I
 do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
 premises unto the said David Devenport his heirs and assigns
 against my self and my heirs and all other persons lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
