

and acknowledgments for the same during her life to the intent and purpose that she may enjoy possess and have the same free from the contract debt contracts liabilities or intermeddling of her present or any future husband during the term of her natural life, provided that in no case shall the trust be held liable to account for such use and profits or rents of said lands as may at any time be received and enjoyed by the said Mrs Eugenia Ann Stone in case of her neglect or refusal to accept for the same. Secondly - In trust that the said Trustee shall have power by Deed or will to appoint a successor to succeed him and to transfer the Trustee Estate to such successor subject nevertheless to the written consent of the said Mrs Eugenia Ann Stone and the said Trustee or his Successor shall have power and authority to write with the said Eugenia Ann Stone and her husband in selling and disposing of any part of said lands. So as to make a proper title to the same and to invest the proceeds in payments for negroes or other property for the separate use and benefit of the said Eugenia Ann during her life, free from all contracts and liabilities of her husband - Thirdly - in trust the said Trustee or his successors after the death of the said Eugenia Ann Stone shall surrender the said lands or property arising from the proceeds thereof unto the children of the said Eugenia Ann Stone then living & if any be dead leaving issue such issue to take the share to which the parent would be entitled if living. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph N Whitner his heirs successors or assigns forever for the use & purposes & trust aforesaid. And we do hereby bind our selves & our heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph N Whitner his heirs assigns & successors against us & our heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof except against the said Mrs Eugenia Ann Stone her heirs & assigns. Rodolphus Long	Trust	To Wit: Whereas by the Decree of the Court of Equity at Pickens Court House for June Term Eighteen Hundred & fifty eight in a bill then filed by Robert A Hawthorn & wife against my self & wife & Anna Perry for a Partition of the Real & Personal Estate of Josiah F Perry deceased a certain portion of the said Estate being one third of the same consisting of a Tract of Land situate lying & being on Shoal Creek waters of the Great River in Pickens District & Eleven Slaves now amongst other things assigned to my wife Susan Long as her Distributive Share of the said Estate and whereas I am desirous of settling all my right title & interest in the said Property real & personal in trust for my said wife during her lifetime & then in trust for any children which we may have & remainder over in case we have none. Now know all men by these presents that I Thomas D Long of the District of Greenville but about to become a resident citizen of Pickens District in the State of South Carolina for & in consideration of the love & affection I have & bear my wife Susan Long formerly Susan Perry & for & in consideration of the sum of Five dollars to me in hand paid by my Brother Doctor Rodolphus D Long of the District of Greenville & State of South Carolina have granted bargained sold & conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell & convey to the said Rodolphus D Long my right title & interest present or future in the said Tract of Land assigned to my wife by the Decree of the Court of Equity above referred to situate lying & being in Pickens District & State of South Carolina on Shoal Creek waters of the Great River being a portion of the tract of Land whenon Josiah F Perry resided at the time of his death & the boundaries of the same will be fully seen & set forth in a Plat of the same made by the Surveyor when the whole tract was partitioned amongst the three children of the said Josiah F Perry deceased & which Plat is filed in the record of the suit for Partition already mentioned. Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Premises in any wise belonging or incident or appertaining. Also the following Slaves Eleven in number viz Jack & his wife Sindy & her six children whose names are not at present remembered also Annetty & her child Sam and also Charley. Together with the future increases of the female Slaves To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned and said Slaves & their increase unto the said Rodolphus D Long his heirs and assigns forever on the following terms & conditions & none other

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
