fection I have for my daughter Francis E Brockman, I do hereby
bequeath to her and her children the following property to be held
by her during her life and after her death to go to her children
if she should have any, otherwise that she have full power to
will the same to any person that she may choose, Viz: one neg-
ro woman named Neala about Twenty two years old and her three
children other future increase also one negro boy Zack about
sixteen years old which property I hereby convey to the said Francis
E Brockman on the terms above specified, and hereby forever
release and relinquish the same, and also warrant and forever
defend the the titles for which I hold my self my heirs executors
and administrators &c Given under my hand and seal this the 18th day
of November Eighteen Hundred Fifty (1850) 3
