 to a Stake 3/4 by a pine thence S 27 W 14.25 to a Stake 3/4 bounded
 by J C Ware thence S 73 E 38.50 to a Post oak 3/4 dead, bounded
 by Mc Berry thence S 22 E 21.90 to Post oak 3/4 dead, bounded
 by Mc Berry thence N 36 E 8.50 to a Stake 3/4 originally Post oak
 3/4 bounded by J Nece thence N 3 W 25.83 to a Stake 3/4 or Red
 oak 3/4 bounded by J C Hooker thence N 45 E 22.00 to dogwood 3/4

 with all and singular the rights members hereditaments

 ises unto the said Harriet YeARGIN his heirs and assigns forever
 and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
 unto the said Harriet YeARGIN his heirs and assigns against my
 self and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever
 lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

I Joseph James of the District and State of said for and in
 consideration of the natural love and affection which I have
 and bear unto my daughter Mrs Caroline Wood widow of Robert
 Wood deceased, as well as for inconsideration of the sum
 of Ten dollars to me in hand paid by William C Bayley, the
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I have given sold and
 conveyed and by these presents do give sell and convey unto
 the said W C Bayley the following female slave named Aggia
 with all her future issue and increase. To have and to hold the said
 female slave with the future increase in trust for the exclusive use
 benefit interest and behoof of my daughter Mrs Caroline Wood for
 and during her natural life and after her death the said female
 slave Aggia with her future increase to be equally divided between and
 among such children as my said daughter Mrs Caroline Wood may
 leave and should any child or children of my said daughter marry
 and have a child or children or a child and die in the lifetime of my
 said daughter leaving a child or children then and in that case
 such child or children as shall be living at the death of my said
 daughter Mrs Caroline Wood shall receive such part as such child
 or childrens part would have been entitled to upon an equal divi-
 sion. It is further expressly declared to be the true intent and meaning
 of this deed that the trustee herein named have no other or further
 interest in the aforesaid female slave than as trustee but merely to
 protect the right and interest of my daughter Mrs Caroline Wood and
 her children who are from time to time and at all times to have the
 service hire uses and enjoyment of the said slave with her future increase
 without let or hindrance by the said trustee or any person by him
 authorized. The said trustee is hereby authorized and empowered in
 case any of slaves should be improperly disposed of contrary to the true
 intent and meaning of this deed to sue for demand and receive
