Carr then in trust for the children of the said Lewis and Emma C. Carr and their heirs forever according to the Statute of distribution of South Carolina provided nevertheless that during the lifetime of the said Mrs Emma C. Carr the said Isaac Woolf trustee as aforesaid may at any time upon obtaining the written consent and direction of the said Mrs Emma C. Carr sell and dispose of the aforesaid lot of land or any part thereof, at publice or private sale, and reinvest the proceeds thereof either in Real or personal Estate as she may so consent and direct and like manner may change such reinvestments, the said fund or reinvestments being however always to be held by the said Isaac Woolf trustee as aforesaid, for and upon the same trusts uses and conditions as hereinbefore expressed and for and upon no other purpose or condition whatsoever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Isaac Woolf trustee as aforesaid his successors heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
