Reason Wallow Deed the State of South Carolina To For Know all men by these presents that Joseph Mc Kinney Land Reason Wallow of Greenville District and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand five hundred dollars in hand paid by Joseph Mc Kinney of Greenville District and State aforesaid have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph Mc Kinney two tracts or parcels of Land situate lying and being in Greenville District and State aforesaid on broad waters of Middle Tyger River the first tract bounded as follows Viz Beginning at a Pine & runs N 7 1/4 W 25.70 to a stone & in place of Pine down thence N 7 W 3.20 to a Pine & thence N 80 1/4 E 5.50 to a stone & thence N 87 1/2 E 4.90 to a stone & thence S 4 1/2 E 4.39 to a chestnut & near a spring thence S 3 1/4 W 10.00 to a Double Mulberry & thence S 3 1/4 W 13.80 to a Persimmon & thence down the branch to the intersection with the Big Branch thence up said branch N 30 1/2 E 10.00 to the beginning Pine corner containing twenty five acres more or less.
