Charles Gosnell	For Land	This indenture made the second

of March in the year of our Lord
 One thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty between
 William M. Thomas Esquire Commissioner of the Honorable
 Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville Court House
 in the said State of the one part and Charles Gosnell son
 of the other part Whereas Charles Gosnell on or about the
 twenty ninth day of March in the year of our Lord One
 thousand eight hundred and fifty eight exhibited his
 bill of complaint in the court of Equity at Greenville Court
 House in the said State against Michael J. Dickey Administrator
 of John W. Hodges deceased et al for title to a tract of
 Land sold by said John W. Hodges to complainant during
 the life time of said John W. Hodges without the execution
 of legal titles, and the cause being at issue the Honorable

Court came on to be heard at July Term in the year of our
 Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty eight when the
 said Court after full hearing and mature deliberation in the
 premises did order adjudge and decree that the Commissioners
 of this Court shall make and execute on the part of the heirs
 of John W. Hodges deceased titles to the tract of Land assign-
 ed in the bond or agreement of the said John W. Hodges
 to the Complainant. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth
 that the said William M. Thomas as Commissioner of the said
 Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consideration
 of the sum of three dollars paid him by the said Charles Gosnell
 for the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
 bargained sold and released and by these presents doth
 grant bargain sell and release unto the said Charles Gosnell Junr
 and his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land
 situate in Greenville District in the State of South Carolina adjoining
 Peter Gosnell Col. Wilson Bartons land for which tract is on both sides
 of Little fall Creek, but this tract is all sold to Gosnell that the
 said Hodges holds in between Peter Gosnell and Col. Wilson Bartons
 land to within one hundred yards of the top of the Falls on Fall
 Creek and the line to run to Bartons line & Dick Howards
 line to be straight line or a line to be made by Gosnell & Hodges
 containing six hundred acres more or less. Together with all
 and singular the hereditaments rights members and appurte-
 nances whatsoever to the said Land belonging, or in anywise
 appertaining, and the reversions and remainders rents Issues
 and profits thereof, and also all the estate right title Interest
 dower Possession property benefit claim and demand whatsoev-
 er both at Law and Equity of the Heirs and representatives
 of the said John W. Hodges deceased, and of the parties to
 this deed and of all other persons rightfully claiming or to
 claim the same or any part thereof by from or under them to
 have and to hold the said Lands with its hereditaments pro-
 tiges and appurtenances unto the said Charles Gosnell Junr
 and his heirs and assigns to him and their only proper
 use and behoof forever. In witness whereof the said
 William M. Thomas as Commissioner of the said Court
 under and by virtue of the said Decree hath hereunto set his
 hand and the Seal of the Court on the day and year first above
