 and fifty between William Mc Thomas Esquire commissioner
 of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at
 Greenville Court House in the said State of the one part
 and Robert McKay Esquire of the other part Whereas John
 Benedict et al on or about the first day of March
 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 fifty six exhibited their Bill of Complaint in the Court of
 Equity at Greenville Court House in the said State aga
 inst Thomas G Benedict and Samuel W Benedict for
 the partition and Sale of the Lands of Isaac Mc Benedict
 deceased and the Cause being at issue before the
 Honorable Court came on to be heard at July Term in
 the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and fifty six when the said Court after full hearing
 thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did
 Order adjudge and Decree that the Lands mentioned in
 the pleadings should be sold at Public Auction by the
 Commissioner of the said Court on the terms and for
 the purposes mentioned in the decretal order as by reference
 thereto in the premises of the said Court will appear and
 the Samuel A Lounes as commissioner of the said Court
 after having duly advertised the said Lands for sale
 by public outcry on the sales day of December in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty six
 did then openly and publicly and according to the custom
 of Auctions sell and dispose of the said land below
 described unto the said Robert McKay Esquire for two
 hundred and eighty dollars being at that price the
 highest bidder for the same Now therefore this Indenture
 Witnesseth that the said William M Thomas as commissioner
 of the said Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and
 in consideration of the sum of three dollars paid him by the
 said Robert McKay Esq the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 hath granted bargained sold and released and by these
 presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said
 Robert McKay Esquire and his heirs and assigns all that
 tract lot or parcel of Land situate in the district and
 State above named near the Town of Greenville on the East
 side of what is known as the Buncombe Road numbered
 on the plat of said Land made by order of the Court of
 Equity for said district and filed with said Bill and other
 papers having reference to the sale of said Real Estate as
 lot No 6 in the case of George W Earle vs Susan W Earle et al
 in this District the said lot having a front of 242 feet on the
 East side of the said Buncombe Road and containing one acre
 and two roods more or less Together with all and singular

the Hereditaments rights members and appurtenances
 whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in anywise app
 ertaining, and the reversions and remainders rents issues

 and tract of land situate lying and being on Keady Fork
 Creek, waters of Keady River in the District and State
 aforesaid adjoining lands of James Lenderman James
 Ashmon John Pollard and others, and having the
 following lines, metes and bounds, viz, beginning at a
 Rock 3^d at the South corner of a field on the Fork Shoal
 Road and running thence with said road N 35 W 9 ch 25 d
