these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said William J West all our right title and interest claim
and demand whatsoever in all that piece parcel and tract
of land lying being and situate in Greenville District on
Reedy River being a part of the real estate of Isaac West
deceased which under the Decree of the Court of Equity
was conveyed by the Commissioners of the said Court to
the Heirs of the said Isaac West deceased Containing
Twenty acres and so laid off as to include Ten acres
on the each side of Reedy river and Ten acres on
the other side of Reedy River and to include the shoal
and water privileges when James West once had a
mill adjoining lands of P. Hough P. H. West and J. H. Smyre
and others. Together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or in anywise incident or
pertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said William J.
West his heirs and assigns forever. And we do hereby
bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said William J. West his
heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and
