

Wm Mc Thomas Deed The State of North Carolina  
 To For this indenture made the third  
 Peter Cauble Land day of September in the year  
 of our Lord One thousand eight  
 Hundred and Sixty between William Mc Thomas Esquire  
 Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville  
 District at Greenville Court House in the said State  
 of the one part and Peter Cauble of the other part  
 Whereas Peter Cauble administrator of all and sing-  
 ular the goods and chattles rights and credits which  
 were of Wm A Cauble Decd, on or about the twenty fifth  
 day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight Hundred and Sixty exhibited his Bill of complaint  
 in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House in the  
 said State against J P Reed Solicitor of the State of  
 South Carolina for the sale of the real estate of said  
 William A Cauble deceased, and the cause being  
 at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be  
 heard at July Term in the year of our Lord one  
 thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty when the said Court  
 after full hearing thereof and mature deliberation in  
 the premises did Order adjudge and decree that the  
 said land should be sold at Public auction by the  
 Commissioner of the said Court on the terms, and for the  
 purposes mentioned in their decretal Order, as by reference  
 thereunto in the registry of the said Court will appear, and  
 the said William Mc Thomas as Commissioner of the said  
 Court after having duly advertised the said land for sale  
 by Public Auction on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of September in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand eight Hundred and Sixty  
 did then openly and <sup>publicly</sup> according to the customs sell  
 and dispose of the said land below described unto the  
 said Peter Cauble for One Hundred and Seventy five  
 dollars being at that price the highest bidder for the  
 same. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth, that  
 the said William Mc Thomas as Commissioner of the said  
 Court under and by virtue of the said Decree and in consid-  
 eration of the sum of Three dollars paid him by the  
 said Peter Cauble the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-  
 ledged, hath granted bargained sold and released and  
 by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release  
 unto the said <sup>Cauble</sup> and his heirs and assigns  
 all that tract or lot of land situate in Greenville District  
 in the State above named in the Town of Greenville on the South  
 Side of Avenue Street adjoining lands of Cleveland Jones  
 North 74 feet West 191 feet South West 172 feet South 74 feet East  
 128 feet North 33. East 186 feet to the beginning corner  
 Together with all and singular the Hereditaments rights mem-  
 bers and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging  
 or in any wise appertaining, and the Reversions and remainders

rents issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate  
 right title interest dower possession property benefit claim  
 and demand whatsoever both at Law and Equity of the  
 heirs and representatives of the said William A Cauble  
 deceased and of the parties to this suit, and of all other  
 persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same or any part  
 thereof by from or under them or either of them, do have and  
 to hold the said Land with its hereditaments privileges  
 and appurtenances unto the said Peter Cauble and his  
 heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use benefit

 Wm J Barton Land this Indenture made the third  
 day of September in the year  
 of our Lord One thousand eight Hundred and Sixty  
 between William Mc Thomas Esquire Commissioner of the  
 Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District at Greenville  
 Court House in the said State of the one part, and William  
 Barton Thomas Barton and Joseph Barton of the other  
 part, Whereas Rebecca Gosnell, et, al, on or about the  
 seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight Hundred and fifty nine exhibited their Bill of compl-  
 aint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House  
 in the said State against Roman L Barton for the partition  
 of the real estate of James W Barton deceased, and the  
 cause being at issue before the Honorable Court came on to be  
 heard at July Term in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 eight Hundred and Sixty when the said Court after full hearing  
 thereof and mature deliberation in the premises did order  
 adjudge and decree that the said real Estate should be  
 sold at Public auction by the Commissioner of the said Court  
 on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their decretal
