W. Garrison since bargaining & selling my Slaves to
Jourdan P Pool & Benjamin F Perry in order to pay
my debts & secure the remainder of the purchase money
to myself hereafter have ascertained that the debts
will greatly exceed the sum of Twenty Five Thousand
dollars, and whereas it becomes necessary to make
a change in my contract with the said Pool & Perry
in relation to the aforesaid trade. Now know all
men by these presents that in considerations of the further
sum of Fifteen Thousand dollars in cash paid me by
the said Jourdan P Pool & Benjamin F Perry the receipt
whereof I do hereby acknowledge I have bargained sold
& delivered by these presents do bargain sell and deliver all
my right title & interest in the said fifteen slaves Jack
Sophronia Jerry Mary & her infant child Henry Andy Betsy
Nancy John Garrison Soniga Pinck Tom Rita & Buster
with the future increase of the female slaves, and I do
warrant & forever defend all & singular my right title and
interest in the said slaves and the said slaves themselves &
their future increase unto the said Jourdan P Pool & Benjamin
& Perry their heirs executors administrators and assigns against
me my heirs executors administrators and all persons claiming
the same, and I do hereby authorize the said Jourdan P Pool & the
said Benjamin F Perry to let the said slaves remain in the
possession of my wife during her life time & then to take
possession of them, and in further consideration of the said
sum of Fifteen Thousand dollars paid me as aforesaid, I have
released the annuity of three hundred dollars which was
to have been paid me & also reduced the bond of the said
Pool & Perry to the sum of Two thousand dollars which
together with the sum of four thousand dollars in cash paid
me makes six thousand dollars for the said slaves, besides
two hundred dollars otherwise paid me
