James Cox Land that I James Lenderman of Green-
ville District and in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars to me in hand
paid by James Cox of the District of Greenville and in the State
aforesaid have granted bargained sold and by these presents do
grant bargain sell and released unto the said James Cox a certain
piece parcel or tract of Land containing One hundred and five acres
be the same more or less situate in the State and District aforesaid
said on both sides of the Reedy fork branch waters of Reedy
River. Beginning at white oak 3+ on near said Reedy
Creek thence N 64 1/2 W 19.05 chs to Rock 3+ on thence S 45 3/4 W 27.00
chs to Rock 3+ on n, thence N 6 1/2 W 27.10 chs to Black Oak 3+ on thence
N 69 1/2 W 21.00 chs to Post oak 3+ on thence N 55 1/2 W 21.00 chs to Maple
3+ on on said Creek thence down the Creek S 64 E 4.60 to Rock thence
N 55 E 2.67 ch to Rock 3+ on thence S 74 E 24.30 chs to the Beginning
white Oak 3+ on. Together with all and singular the
rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to
the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular
the premises before mentioned unto the said James Cox
his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind
my self my heirs Exeutors and Administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said James Cox his heirs and assigns against my self
and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim the same as any part thereof

To of This Indenture made the nineteenth
L H Shumate & Robert Allison Trust day of October in the year one thousand
Allison eight hundred and sixty between

Robert Bolling of Greenville District and State of South
Carolina of the first part, and L H Shumate & Robert Allison
of the same place of the second part, Whereas the said
Robert Bolling is desirous to make provisions for his grand
children Mary Ann Allison now of the age of twenty two
years Robert Allison aged twenty one William Allison
aged eighteen Abigail Allison aged sixteen James Allison
aged seventeen Margaret aged eleven and Rachel Caroline
aged nine years all the children of my daughter Carolina
Allison now deceased against future contingences, and
for their maintenance and support, and when as the said
Robert Bolling is desirous that his said grand children
should enjoy and inherit the slaves herein after named
and their future increase. Now therefore this Indenture
witnesseth that the said Robert in consideration of the
premises, and of the sum of one dollar to him in hand
paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained sold
and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
and convey unto the said parties of the said part a certain
family of Negroes viz, Mary aged about twenty eight years
& her four children viz, William Sam Mary and Martha
together with their future increase and also all the right
title interest property possession claim, and demand
whatsoever as well at law as in Equity of the said party
of the first part of in or to the above named, Negroes and
and their future increase to have and to hold all and
singular the above mentioned negroes and their future increase
unto the said L H Shumate & Robert Allison their heirs
and assigns, In trust and to and for the several uses intents
