I trust to deliver them to William Allison the Father of the above named children, and to let them remain with him during his sojourn in the neighborhood until the youngest child before named, viz, Rachel Caroline is married or arrives at the age of twenty one year at which time the said Negroes are to be sold or put in as many lots as their own children and all to be made equal if lotted by those drawing lots of the most value to pay to those drawing lots of less value and if sold the money to be equally divided among the above named grand children if living & if any of them should die before a division and leave children then the children to receive the part that their parent would have been entitled to if living the trustees above named if they see proper and think it advisable have the right to take the property into their possession at any time and to hire it out & the hire to be collected & paid to the distributees at the time above designated, and the said parties of the second part doth hereby signify their acceptance of this trust, and do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said party of the first part faithfully to discharge and execute the same according to the true intent and meaning of these presents.
