at and before the sealing and delivery of the present to the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained  
sold and conveyed and doth by these presents grant  
bargain sell and convey unto the said Joel E Morris his  
heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land lying  
and being in Greenville District South Carolina containing  
three hundred acres more or less it being one fifth of the  
same, and said Land being that given by Israel Miller to  
Rebecca Bradley and her children the said Susan Bradley  
being one of her children the said Land lying on Enoree River  
and Brushy Creek. To have and to hold said tract or  
parcel of Land unto the said Joel E Morris his heirs and  
assigns together with all and singular the rights members  
and appurtenances thereto to the same for any manner belonging to  
him and their own proper use benefit and behoof in full  
simple and the said Susan Bradley for her heirs executors  
and administrators the said bargained premises unto the said  
Joel E Morris his and assigns will warrant and forever defend  
the right and title thereto against the claims of all other persons
