



Jane Gault & John Gault Deed The State of South Carolina

 granted bargained sold and released, and by these  
 presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
 the said Newton Babb all that tract of land known  
 as the part Peden Tract containing 136, one hundred  
 and thirty six acres situated in the District aforesaid  
~~beginning~~<sup>beginning</sup> on a White oak thence S64°8' N79.50 thence S25 W  
 5 S64°28' E14 bounded by R Brysons White oak stump thence S67  
 E44 to Pine bounded by Thomas Goldsmith thence N40°2' E11 30 to  
 Stake N75 6 to a Stake thence N4 28 4 thence S58 8 to Stake  
 thence N12 1/2 E10.16 to Stake bounded by J. Thompson thence N64  
 W57.50 the beginning bounded by John Gault
