 the seventh day of September in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and sixty exhibited their bill of
 complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville Court House
 in the said State against Belton O Mauldin et al for the
 Partition of the real Estate of Samuel Mauldin deceased
 and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court
 came on to be heard at Chambers, Term in the year of our
 Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty when the said
 Court after full hearing thereof, and mature deliberation
 in the premises, did order adjudge and decree that the
 said real estate should be sold at Public Auction by
 the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms and for
 the purposes mentioned in their decretal order, as by refer-
 ence thereto in the registry of the said Court, will appear

 Court after having duly advertised the said real estate
 for sale by public Auction on the third of December in
