This indenture made the third day
of September in the year of our Lord
One thousand eight hundred and

Sixty between William M Thomas Esquire Commissioner
of the Honorable Court of Equity for Greenville District
at Greenville Court House in the said State of the one
part and Samuel Green of the other part, Whereas
George H Burgess and Patience his wife on or about
the twenty sixth day of November in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty exhibited their
Bill of complaint in the Court of Equity at Greenville
Court House in the said State against James Ward Susan
Ward et al for the partition and sale of the real estate
of Henry Rains deceased, and the cause being at issue
before the Honorable Court came on to be heard at July
Term in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and sixty when the said Court after full hearing thereof and
mature deliberation in the premises did order and adjudge
and decree that the said land should be sold at public
auction by the Commissioner of the said Court on the terms
and for the purposes mentioned in their decreat order, as by
referance thereto in the registry of the said Court will
appear, and the said William M Thomas as Commissioner
of the said Court after having duly advertised the said land
for sale by public outcry on the 3rd day of September in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty did
then openly and publicly and according to the custom of
auction sell and dispose of the said land below described
unto the said Samuel Green for four hundred dollars
being at that price the highest bidder for the same.

Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said
William M Thomas as Commissioner of the said Court
under and by Virtue of the said Decree and in considera-
tion of the sum of three dollars paid him by the said
Samuel Green the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
hath granted bargained sold and released and by these
presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the
said Samuel Green heirs and assigns all that tract of
land situate in Greenville District in the State above
named on waters of Brushy Creek Branch waters of
Enoree River containing forty six and one half acres
more or less adjoining lands of Ross Holt, claws Rains
and estate of Rains commencing on the creek at a
State of N m N 13 W 13, 33 to a State 3+3 x N m N 70 1/2 E
28, 40 to a State 3+3 x m S 35 1/2 E 10, 30 to a State 3 x m
on the creek up said creek to the begining corner
Together with all and singular the hereditaments
rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the
said Land belonging or in anywise appertaining, and
the reversions and remainders rents issues and profits
