This Indenture made the Twenty  
ninth day of April in the  
year of our Lord one thousand

eight hundred and fifty five between Benjamin R Allender  
of the one part and Jacob Land of Greenville District  
of the other part witnesseth Whereas the said Jacob Land  
stands indebted to B R Allender in the sum of Fifteen  
Dollars on Sealed Note dated 29<sup>th</sup> April 1857 with interest  
from date made payable six months after date. Now this  
Indenture witnesseth That the said Jacob Land for and  
in consideration of one dollar and also in considera-  
tion of the sum of the better securing the payment of the  
said Note of Fifteen dollars to the said B R Allender by him  
the said Jacob Land the Dollars in hand paid at and  
before the sealing and delivery of these presents do grant  
hang all his release convey and confirm unto  
the said B R Allender and to his heirs and assigns  
forever Two work Steers which is now about Four years  
old one of them a Red one and the other one a Pided  
one. Together with all and singular the rights mem-  
bers and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any  
wise appertaining. To have and to hold the said the  
Two named Steers unto the said B R Allender his heirs  
and assigns forever. Provided always nevertheless  
and it is the true intent and meaning of the parties  
to these presents that if the said Jacob Land, execu-  
tors or administrators shall well and truly pay or  
cause to be paid unto the said B R Allender the  
sum of Fifteen dollars and interest on the same  
according to the tenor and effect of the said note  
above mentioned then and from thenceforth these pres-  
ents shall be utterly null and void. any thing herein  
contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwith-  
standing. and it is covenanted and agreed upon by  
and between the parties to these presents that until  
default shall be made in payment of the aforesaid sum as  
before set forth, and the interest for the same, it shall and  
may be lawful to and for the said Jacob Land peaceably  
and quietly to hold and occupy possess and enjoy the said  
Steers and every part thereof with the appurtenances and  
to hold receive and take the rents issues and profits  
thereof to his own particular use and behoof. any thing  
herein contained to the contrary hem of in any wise notwith-  
standing. Witness my hand and seal this Twenty ninth  
day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and fifty seven and in the year of the Sovereignty  
and Independence of the United States of America
