 and taken of the lands and tenements of the said Harald  
 Wyllys all that certain piece parcel and tract of  
 Land containing One Hundred & Thirty mon or less  
 acres situate and being in the District of Greenville  
 on waters of Laurel Creek adjoining lands of W A  
 McDaniel J Henry Stokes & Elizabeth McDaniel et al  
 and wheras the said premises with their appurtenances  
 since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said Writ of  
 fieri facias before mentioned have been exposed to sale at  
 public vendue and purchased by Col E S Irvine in the  
 District of Greenville for the sum of Three Hundred Dollars  
 being the highest sum that was bidder therfor Now know  
 ye that I J T McDaniel Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the  
 said writ of fieri facias to me directed and delivered  
 aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such case  
 made and provided and for and in consideration of the  
 said sum of Three Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid  
 or secured to be paid by the said E S Irvine the receipt  
 and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted  
 bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain  
 and sell unto the said Col E S Irvine his heirs and assigns  
 forever the said tract piece and parcel of land with its  
 appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest  
 which the said Harald Wyllys of right had of in and to  
 the same to have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract  
 of land with its appurtenances unto the said E S Irvine  
 his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as  
 the said J T McDaniel Sheriff might could or ought to grant
