 William Davis }
 Know all men by these presents

that we William Manning Austin and Nathaniel Austin are held and bound unto William H Davis in the penal sum of three thousand dollars good and lawful money to the payment of which sum we bind our selves each and either of us jointly and severly, together with our heirs executors and administrators firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this the 14 day of February A D 1861 Whereas the above named William H Davis his executed a deed of trust to the above named William Manning Austin of Divers sums amounting in gross to thirteen hundred and seven by seven Dollars and sixteen cents, and whereas it is stipulated in said deed of trust that the said William Manning Austin shall keep the said fund and pay to the said William H Davis annually, either the interest thereon or pay for him to meet necessities the said interest only, except in such years when sickness or other misfortune may increase his necessities to more than the interest when the whole of said sum may be paid by Austin for Davis and whereas the said Austin is to make annual returns of his actions and doings, by agreement which this paper and the said trust deed witnesseth to the commissioner in Equity for Greenville District providing his vouchers and subject in all respects to said court of equity as a Guardian and whereas it is further stipulated that the said Manning Austin shall pay to the heirs of the said William H Davis the amount which may be due to him the said Davis at his death or to his Executor or administrator

Now the condition of the above obligation is such that if the above named William Manning Austin shall well and truly discharge the duties and trust aforesaid according to the agreements herein mentioned then the said bond to be null and void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
