 Richard F Foster Property Know all men by these presents
 that I John Samuel Foster of
 the District and State aforesaid in consideration of the
 natural love and affection which I have and bear for
 and towards my brother Richard F Foster of the said
 State and District, and in further consideration of
 the sum of Ten dollars to me paid by the said Richard
 F Foster, and in further consideration, that the said
 Richard F Foster will pay off, satisfy and discharge
 all debts which I may now be owing, have given granted
 bargained, sold delivered, and release, and by these
 presents do hereby give grant bargain sell deliver
 and release unto the said Richard F Foster all
 and singular the piece parcel and tract of land
 containing seven hundred and sixty acres, be the
 same, more or less, situate lying and being in the
 District and State aforesaid on South Saluda River
 adjoining lands of Mays, Abial Foster R F Foster
 and others being the same tract of land which I
 received from my father Robert S C Foster deceased
 and on which I now live, and also ten negroes
 to wit Lawyer, Jenney, Aleck, Cyrus, Lewis, Ann, Catherine,
 Silda, Jim, and Mariah and also one sorrel mare
 One mouse colored mule, one buggy and harness
 five head of cattle, three head of hogs, one still and
 stands two rifle guns one double barrel shot gun
 one repeating pistol, my present stock of corn Bacon
 and other provisions, my household and kitchen
 furniture, my farming and other tools, and any
 other personal property which I may own together
 with all and singular the rights members incidents
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said prem-
 ises slaves and other property belonging, or in any
 wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold
 all and singular the premises slaves and other
 property before mentioned unto the said Richard
 F Foster his heirs Executors administrators and
 Assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self, my
 heirs executors and administrators to warrant and
 forever defend all and singular the said premises
 slaves and other property unto the said Richard
 F Foster his heirs Executors, administrators and
 assigns, against myself my heirs executors and
 administrators and against every other person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this
 52 third day of April in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and sixty one, and
